



## School Uniform

All of our children wear uniform to promote the identity of our school, to promote the feeling of community within the school and as a badge of pride. Our school uniform expectations ensure children are dressed appropriately for learning and play. We appreciate your support in upholding our uniform expectations.

### **GIRLS**

Winter:

- Grey skirt, pinafore dress or grey trousers
- White short sleeved polo shirt (plain or with school logo)
- Red school sweatshirt/sweat cardigan
- Grey or red tights or white socks
- Black shoes NOT trainers or boots (please ensure your child can change these independently)

Summer:

- Red check dress
- Red school sweatshirt/cardigan
- White socks
- Black shoes

### **BOYS**

Winter:

- Grey trousers
- White short sleeved polo shirt (plain or with school logo)
- Red school sweatshirt
- Grey socks
- Black shoes NOT trainers (please ensure your child can change these independently)

Summer:

- Grey shorts
- White polo shirt (plain or with school logo)
- Red school sweatshirt
- Grey socks
- Black shoes

### **PE KIT – not required for Nursery**

- Pumps (Velcro or elasticated fastening)
- White T'shirt
- Navy blue shorts

### **BOOK BAGS AND PE BAGS**

Should you need to purchase a book bag or PE bag, please make the required payment in cash at the school office.

Book bags are priced at £6.00 and PE bags at £2.00.

### **PLEASE NOTE**

- All items of clothing **must** be named; this makes it far easier for us to reunite your child with lost items
- In the winter children can travel to school in their boots/wellies but must change into black shoes or pumps once they are inside the school building
- For safety reasons children are not allowed to wear jewellery of any kind in school. Pierced earrings are particularly dangerous and should not be worn under any circumstances. Please talk to the Headteacher if you belong to a religion that demands the wearing of jewellery as an essential and **mandatory** part of that faith
- In the summer, children may wish to wear a sun hat or cap whilst outside
- Hair should be appropriate for school. Extreme hairstyles, colours and shaved patterns/lines are not permitted
- Hair accessories should be in school colours (red, white, navy blue or black). Large bows or headbands are not allowed
